In terms of Regulation 30 and Schedule III to the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations'), read with the SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024 ('SEBI Master Circular'), this is to inform you that the Company has received show cause notice (DRC 01) from the "Deputy Commissioner of State Goods and Service Tax, Balasore under section 73 of the Central GST Act, 2017 & SGST Act, 2017 and IGST Act, 2017 on September 26, 2025.

There is no material impact on financial, operation or other activities of the Company. Further, the Company firmly believes that it maintains strong legal and factual grounds and is fully prepared to address and contest the aforesaid show cause notice. The Company is in the process of reviewing the matter and will take necessary actions in accordance with applicable laws.

The outstanding Vendors as on 31.03.2022 of the Company as a whole are considered and showed as payment not made within 180 days. The same is not tenable as per the company since outstanding vendors as on 31.03.2022 should have been considered only for GSTN of Company's plant for which DRC-1 is received rather than as a whole. The 18% liability has been inadvertently calculated on the entire outstanding of Vendors and showed the same in DRC 01. The Company has made almost all the payments within 180 days for outstanding vendors as on 31.03.2022.  There is no material impact on financial, operation or other activities of the Company.
